### Adorers on move in the footsteps of

#### St. Maria De Mattias, Girl in a Hurry

To hear the cry of the helpless even amidst this pandemic is a call of the divine. As soon as the month of May began I have been out back into the streets to search for the slum dwelling children to place them in a safe home which we call "DIN foster home". I work with a non-government organization called as DREAM INDIA NETWORK, under Bengaluru Diocese. This is an Inter Congregation developmental project. Presently I am been appointed as the director for the foster homes. We have 65 centres in Bengaluru and outskirts of Bengaluru.

We three sisters from three different Congregations comprise a team and we go for field work together to search for rag pickers and slum dwellers, street abandoned children. This year we have opened almost ten new foster homes as we have an increase in the number of slum dwellers.



Once we select these children we have been sending them to our quarantine centres for 14 days of quarantine before admitting them into the foster homes. In the quarantine centres the Covid 19 test are done to them. After that once the result is negative they are placed into the respective home and then after orientation we begin with online counselling, group therapy and workshops. We also try to get some domestic worker jobs for the single parent. We also recruit them in English medium schools so that they get a privilege to study in NCERT, ICSE, CBSE syllabus.

The foster home comprises of one foster mother for 8 children. The children have a wonderful time table where they get opportunity to learn music, dance, yoga, art and craft etc. The children above 13 are given career guidance and the other receive other helps to develop their talents. I feel great satisfaction saving few souls for Jesus through this beautiful ministry. I have been also training the teachers of the Archdiocese of





Bangalore to become part time counsellor. We have received many Child sexual abuse cases and also child neglect cases. Those students who have completed ten and twelfth are promoted to study further according to their calibre. Thus these little ones grow mature and responsible. We also teach our children to be confident in their skills like cooking, stitching etc. even before placing the children we try to find out sponsor for the children. Once things of the school admission are over we begin with producing the children to CWC (Commission for Women and Child).

During this Pandemic I was also involved in catering our services to the transgender who were very badly been treated in an inhuman way. Whenever they approached people or went to sell out their vegetable people sprayed sanitizer on their face, splashed water and chased them. We have been simultaneously helping some families to get employment. I am happy to do my service inspite of daily increasing number of Covid 19 infected and affected people all round Bengaluru , lockdown and lack of public transportation. By trusting in the providential assistance of God able to do the ministry with much love, compassion and care like St.Maria De Mattias, for the people of God.





**The Pandemic Covid - 19 -  
Paradigm shift in the  
Education**

**The Era of Online Teaching - Virtual  
Classrooms**

The world at large is experiencing this shift in the field of education. For the students who were not allowed to use mobiles in the schools, it was mandatory to use mobiles for their learning process. Switching from traditional classroom and face to face instructor training to computer-based training in a virtual classroom makes the learning experience entirely different for students. Their resistance to change does not allow them to adapt to the online environment, whereas it takes time for them to get accustomed to the methods of computer based education. Many students are not provided with high bandwidth or strong internet connection that online classes require and thus fail to catch up with their virtual classmates. Time management is a difficult task for e-Learners, as online classes require a lot of time and intensive work. They who like to play outside, were asked to be confined to their homes. Not able to move with their friends, no celebrations, no shopping, no games. It is beyond their imagination.

Parents get fed up with their children because when the children were going to school, they had set a timetable like going to school, coming back from the school doing their home works, little time to relax, and then time for tuition and go to sleep. But now, they are to be monitored always by the parents. Today, parents do not want to be disliked by their children, as a matter of fact parents does everything according to the likings of their children. They don't have the courage to correct their children. Therefore monitoring their children becomes very tiresome for the parents.

For us in St. Maria School Ranchi, it is a time of crisis, uncertainties and tension. The new academic year was to begin from 16 March 2020. Everything was set to begin. But a rumor of lockdown was going on and we could not open the school. Classes had begun for class 10 even that we had to stop on 22<sup>nd</sup> of March. We never expected that this lockdown will be prolonged so much. We had very tough time to have proper communication with the parents and students. Many of the parents are just able to meet their daily needs. Some others are struggling very much. We can say that very few are well off to manage any situation.

We have started interacting with our students through worksheets and assignments for first few days. The online classes had begun in the month of May. Few students were not able to attend online classes due to network problem, interrupted electricity and non-availability of smart phones. Anyhow 60% of the students started attending the online classes. Teachers had to call the parents many times in order to make their children attend the classes. Monthly fee collection was another herculean task. The government of Jharkhand was very much supportive to the parents but not to the private schools. The staff were paid only half salary. We had to depend on the region even for the same. We were not having sufficient amount in the bank. After giving the notice for many times and calling the parents for a meeting, few of them started responding. It was a nightmare for us thinking of staff salary and poor response of the parents with regard to the payment of the fees. At the same time we were at the side of the

parents who are literally having nothing to pay.

Corona Virus has affected our lives in several ways. The virus has created an alarming situation. It's a situation of tension everywhere and has affected everyone's life drastically. 




